WIFFLE BALL TOURNAMENT July 28, 2010

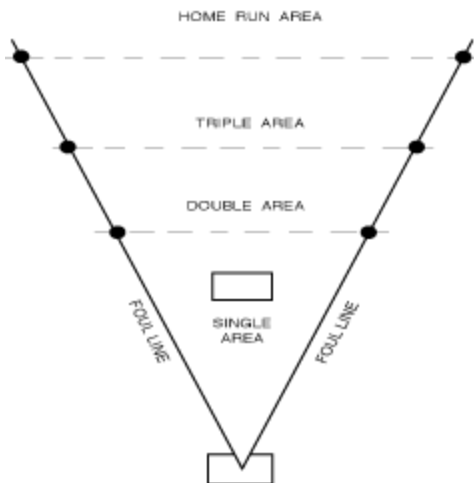


WIFFLE BALL in place of baseball, it's light in weight and cannot be thrown or hit any great distance.

The Pitches

The WIFFLE ball is thrown like a baseball and will curve very easily. The diagrams below show how the ball should be held for curving and controlling the ball.

Experiment with different grips and releases to find the pitches that work best for you. There is no need to throw the ball hard to produce results!



The Wiffle Ball Tournament will be played with each player as his own team. The playing field is the church parking lot, dimension of 20 feet in width at the home run markers (approx. 8 paces) by about 60 feet long (approx. 23 paces) from home plate to each home run marker. The field is laid out with foul lines and

markers for singles, doubles triples and home run areas.
